

ALSS Honorary Lifetime Membership

Information

I. **The Purpose of Honorary Recognition**

Honorary Lifetime Memberships are granted by ALSS to recognize former administrators of Lutheran High Schools and to encourage continued relationships between ALSS and former Lutheran High School administrators.

II. **The Qualifications**

- A. ALSS Honorary Lifetime Membership may be granted to any retired, former Lutheran high school administrator who has faithfully served in an ALSS school and who has attended ALSS conventions.
- B. ALSS Honorary Lifetime Membership may also be granted to any individual who has made significant contributions to Lutheran secondary education whether or not he/she is retired.

III. **The Procedures: Nomination, Approval, and Awarding of ALSS Honorary Lifetime Memberships**

- A. Individuals may be nominated for Honorary Membership in ALSS by a dated resolution from the faculty of an ALSS school or by any head administrator of an ALSS high school.
- B. Nominations are to be submitted to the ALSS Executive Board at least two months prior to the next ALSS convention, using the ALSS nomination form. Biographical and personal information about the candidate is required.
- C. The Executive Board of ALSS will act upon their commendations/nominations received.
- D. The nomination will be endorsed by the Association of Lutheran Secondary Schools at the convention at which the membership is to be bestowed.
- E. The Honorary Lifetime Memberships will then be presented in person, or if necessary, in absentia, at the annual convention.

IV. **The Benefits of Honorary Lifetime Memberships**

- A. ALSS Honorary Lifetime Members will be included on the regular ALSS mailing list.
- B. Registration fees for convention and annual dues will be waived for ALSS Honorary Lifetime Memberships.

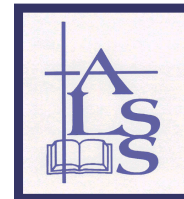
